London International Airport Announces New Non-Stop Flights to Chicago on United Airlines

London International Airport announced today new non-stop jet service from London to Chicago O'Hare International Airport starting September 29th, 2009 on United Airlines. United's schedule out of London includes two direct flights to and from Chicago each day. From Chicago, travelers can make connections through O'Hare to hundreds of U.S. and worldwide destinations.

United Express partner SkyWest will operate the flight utilizing Canadian made CRJ Regional Jets. The 50 seat CRJ is a comfortable and fast regional jet that will have a flying time to Chicago of approximately 1 hour and twenty minutes.
