WestJet to Provide Direct Orlando, Florida Service from London

London International Airport and WestJet Airlines announced today it would launch a new direct jet service from London to Orlando, Florida commencing *February 17th, 2009* and running each *Tuesday through to the end of April*. All flights will operate with WestJet's Boeing 737 jet aircraft.

The flight departs from London at *3:30 p.m.* arriving in Orlando at *6:03 p.m.* allowing Londoners to escape the cold of winter to the warmth of Florida in 2-1/2 hours.

“This new direct service will provide another non-stop jet connection from London with low cost service to greatly benefit travellers to and from London and our region of Southwestern Ontario. This destination is the most popular of all Florida destinations, especially among those who vacation or live in Florida in the winter; or those who are travelling to see Walt Disney World,” said Steve Baker, President, London International Airport. “We are thrilled that WestJet continues to expand their service from London and we encourage travellers to support this new service and help us expand the destinations from London”. WestJet currently offers direct jet service to Calgary and Winnipeg from London with connections throughout their system to destinations in North America and the Caribbean.

London International Airport continues to achieve unprecedented passenger growth. Passenger volumes have experienced double digit increases for three years running, and are expected to continue to rise as more destinations and direct flights are added to London's flight schedule. In the last three years the Airport's passenger levels increased by 51%. Year-to-date they grew an additional 8% over 2007.
