\$6.5 Million Terminal Expansion Opens Today:

Mayor Joe Fontana and Janet Stewart, Chair of the Greater London International Airport Authority officially opened the new Departure Lounge at London International Airport. “It’s one more positive step for our community” said Fontana. “London International Airport has transformed into a modern, friendly and welcoming airport and the new expansion looks fantastic”.

“Its exciting progress for us” says Janet Stewart. “The success and growth of the airport over the last decade requires that we continue to invest in the Terminal Building to ensure that growth can continue. We’ve invested close to \$50 million in the Airport in the last decade and we’re confident that these investments will help us grow from a cargo, passenger and business development perspective”.

The new \$6.5 million Terminal Expansion includes:

- 18,000 square foot expansion to the Departure Lounge that now can seat up to 600 passengers
- Four jet bridges that connect aircraft directly to the terminal
- Expanded passenger services including food and beverage and washroom facilities
- Free Wireless Internet
- Common Use Technology that allows the airlines full flexibility for gate assignment
