United Airlines “Kicks-Off” New Service in London

London International Airport is thrilled to announce that United Airlines first flight to Chicago from London departed today at 4:53 pm.

United Airlines is operating two flights daily to/from Chicago using their 50 seat, CRJ Regional Jet.
